



### Mouse Trace

#### ACTIVITY 1: Trace a shape

Choose a simple shape, the square is a good one to start with. Select the pencil at the top of the box and very carefully trace over the shape, and try to keep on the line. Now select the 'hide' button. This will remove the shape you drew over. You can see your work now.

How did you do?

#### Do you want to save your picture?

Click on the 'snapshot' icon. You can write your name in the box if you like. Click 'yes' to save and 'ok' to continue.

You can look at your picture at any time by clicking on the icon 'visit the gallery'. This is found at the bottom left hand corner of the screen on the main menu.



#### ACTIVITY 2: What can you make out of a circle?

Choose the circle shape and trace over it.

Use the pencil to add features to change the simple circle into an object. It can be made into lots of different things e.g. a face, a clock, a teapot. See how many objects you can make each time you trace round the circle.

Save your picture – see the instructions in activity 1.



## Activities and Ideas Sheet

### ACTIVITY 3: Flowerpot

Choose the flowerpot from the picture bank and carefully trace over it. Use the pencil to add more flowers of your own to the pot. Don't forget to 'hide' your original shape before you print your picture out! Colour in your pot of flowers – you could cut it out and glue it onto card and send it to your friend.

Save your picture – see the instructions in activity 1.
